

## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the College of Micronesia-FSM contracted BECA International Consultant, Ltd. to conduct a Space Utilization and Master Plan Facilities Study in Spring of 2013 to help determine priorities for capital resources that respond to the college's forward strategic direction and links to the integrated Educational Master Plan;

WHEREAS, the COM-FSM has received from BECA International Consultant, Ltd the outcome of the study and has used the results to help with increased rigor in decision making regarding new facilities construction, ensure adequate maintenance of the college facilities which will translate to good upkeep of grounds and campus environments conducive to learning;

WHEREAS, the COM-FSM Administration accepted the outcome of the study based on a fifteen(15) years Facilities Phased Implementation Plan for the new Chuuk Campus Nantaku Site to begin planning for on site infrastructure servicing on roads, sewerage, water, power, telecoms supply, construction of three buildings for the first phase and two buildings in the second phase of the plan with cost estimates;

WHEREAS, COM-FSM and its contractors would require good road access to the new construction site for transporting supplies and equipment and for staff and students access to the campus;

WHEREAS, FSM National and Chuuk State governments suspended the construction of the new road leading to the Nantaku Chuuk Campus Site in Mechitiw Village;

WHEREAS, Chuuk State and COM-FSM will use the road to access the new Nantaku Chuuk campus on a regular basis for educational purposes;

BE IT RESOLVED, that COM-FSM requests the FSM National Government and Chuuk State Government to reinstate the access road in the first phase of the Weno road construction project that leads up to the College's proposed permanent site at Nantaku.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of the resolution be transmitted to His Excellency Emanuel Mori, President of FSM, the Honorable Johnson Elimo, Governor of Chuuk State, the Honorable Mark Mailo, Senate President of Chuuk State Legislature and the Honorable Inocentie Oneisom, Speaker of Chuuk State Legislature.
